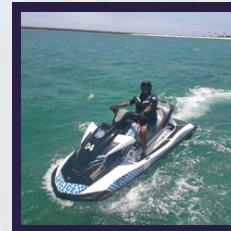

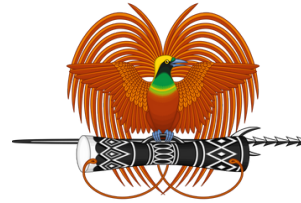

Police Regular Recruit Program Entry Requirement

Key Eligibility Criteria:

- Papua New Guinea Citizen
- Aged between **20 - 30** years
- Evidence of a **Grade 12** school certificate from an approved and government-certified educational institution.
- Minimum of **Year 12** with **"C"** Grades in **English** and **Mathematics**
- **Physically and Medically Fit** - Fitness Test & Medical assessment will be required
- Height – **158** Female & **160** Male
- Must not have any criminal records or a previously dismissed RPNGC member.
- Sound English speaking & writing skills

When applying, your application must include the following:

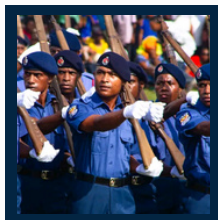
1. A completed and signed **Online Application Form** with passport size photo.
2. An **Expression of Interest Letter**
3. An updated **Resume/CV**
4. Copies of **Gr.10** and **12 Certificates** including academic transcripts if upgraded.
5. Copies of **NID Card / Birth Certificate**

"All required documents must be scanned into one PDF and uploaded through the link provided on the RPNGC website."

RPNGC Recruitment Process

- Screening/Validation
- Testing
- Interview
- Fingerprint/Forensic
- Medical Checks
- Physical Fitness Test
- Reference Check

At the completion of the formal recruitment and selection process at designated Selection Centre, successful candidate are shortlisted and onboarded for training at NCOE, Bomana.

HOW TO APPLY

Below are the processes or steps to follow when uploading your application online.

- Go to www.rpngc.gov.pg → **"Career with RPNGC"** → **"Regular Recruitment"**.
- Read all requirements and click **APPLY**.
- Fill in the **Online Application Form** and upload a clear **ID photo**.
- State why you want to join and **provide three (3) referees**.
- Type your **name** to declare all information is true.
- Scan all required documents into **ONE PDF**, saved under your name.
- Upload the **PDF** and click **SUBMIT**.
- Check your email for submission confirmation and application status (Accepted/Rejected).
- **Successful applicants** will be advised of interview dates online.
- **Hard-copy applications will not be accepted.**
